

LUPRON/LEUPROLIDE ACETATE SUBCUTANEOUS INJECTION

- 1. Give injections same time every day (morning or evening). Some protocols for selective responders may require morning **and** evening injections.
- 2. Wash your hands.
- 3. Use only an orange-top Monoject Insulin Syringe that is supplied with the Lupron Kit. The pharmacy may provide you with additional insulin syringes.
- 4. Pull up dosage measurement of air. Wipe off top of medication vial with an alcohol swab.
- 5. Inject the air into the vial. Invert the vial so the needle is below the vial and pull up your dosage of Lupron. Remove the needle from the vial.
- 6. With needle facing towards the ceiling, tap the syringe so the air bubbles go towards the tip of the needle and *gently* push the air out. Be careful not to push any of the Lupron out.
- 7. Gently put the needle cap back on the syringe, place the syringe nearby and begin to prepare the site for injection.
- 8. Choose site for injection. Remember to alternate sites for each injection.
- 9. Clean site with an alcohol swab in a bull's-eye motion from center outward.
- 10. Gently "pinch up" a two-inch fold of skin.
- 11. Insert needle into the skin with one quick motion.
- 12. Anchor syringe with your hand while releasing with the other.
- 13. Push plunger *slowly*.
- 14. Pull needle straight out of the skin, wipe gently with a cotton ball and apply a Band-Aid if needed.
- 15. Always dispose needles safely into a biohazard container. DO NOT RECAP needles after injections.

REMINDER: ONLY USE SPECIFIED ORANGE-CAPPED LUPRON SYRINGES FOR LUPRON INJECTIONS.
